The Impact of Bereavement on Children and Young People

Bereavement affects children's health, increasing their risk of anxiety and depression. Bereaved children may:

- underachieve at GCSE
- are more likely to be involved in the criminal justice system
- are more likely to be unemployed at 30

With support, they can be helped to manage the impact of death on their lives.



Outcomes of the course

This short introductory course will support professionals to better understand the theory that underpins bereavement support. We will explore some ideas for practical interventions that can help bereaved children and young people and enable your school become 'bereavement friendly'. The core outcome of the training will be enabling and building confidence so that practitioners can deliver bereavement care within their own professional setting. You don't have to be an expert to support a grieving child; we can all play a part in ensuring that the impact of bereavement is not catastrophic.
